Job will be washing & supply of washed coal from existing washeries currently operating in the vicinity of **IB-Valley area of MCL** and final loading to Railway wagons for transportation to WBPDC's Power Station/s. Tender paper will be available through written application to the DGM (FM) at the above address against deposition of **Rs. 5,000/-** (Rs. five thousand only) in the form of 'Non refundable Demand Draft in favour of **'The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited'** from any nationalized bank, payable at Kolkata. Tender paper will not be issued in any other mode of payment.

1. **Issue of Tender** - The tender papers will be available from **24.5.2010 to 04.6.2010** in between **11:00 hrs to 15:00** hrs (except Holidays, Saturday and Sunday) from the office of the Deputy General Manager (Fuel Management), WBPDC, Bidyut Unnayan Bhaban, 3rd Floor, 3/C LA Block, Sector -III, Saltlake City, Kolkata – 700 098. On written request, the document/s shall be issued against deposition of **Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only)** for each tender by Non refundable Demand Draft in favour of **'The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited'**, payable at Kolkata.. Tender paper will not be issued in any other mode of payment.

2. **Submission of enquiry i.r.t tender/s-** After procurement of the tender document/s, party / parties may submit in writing to Deputy General Manager (Fuel Management), within **10.6.2010 -15-00 hrs** the queries if any on the terms and conditions etc.

3. **Pre bid discussion** – In the Pre bid meeting (pre bid discussion) on **12.6.2010 at 12:00 hrs**, the points raised by the party/ parties, any other points required to be discussed further as desired by WBPDC are to be clarified / modified. Out come of the meeting will be a part of the tender which has / have to be followed by all tenderers irrespective of their participation in the pre bid discussion. Part I and Part-II will be opened on the same date i.e. **22.6.2010** at **15-00 hr**. After scrutinizing part I & II, part III & part IV will be opened subsequently. The date of opening part III & part IV would be intimated in due course. Papers containing envelope of each part should be super scribed also (viz. envelope containing Earnest Money should be superscribed as “Earnest Money against Tender No ...”). No tender will be accepted by post.

5. Qualifying Requirement –

5 Qualifying requirements for tenderers:

The Bidders shall possess following minimum qualifying requirements as under:

- 5.1 Location of the washery should be in the vicinity of **Ib valley area** of M/s Mahanadi Coal Fields Limited, Orissa as near to the Mines and to the Railhead as possible.
- 5.2 Tenderer must have a coal washery having minimum washing capacity of 4.0 Million Tonnes per annum in terms of RAW COAL.
- 5.3 The bidders must have document related to the wash ability characteristic of “F” grade ROM coal that would be normally supplied to the Washery as per the monthly allotted quantity.
- 5.4 The Tenderer must be capable of supplying washed coal from their washery within ten days after release of Delivery order by MCL.
- 5.5 The Tenderer must have adequate experience , tools, machinery , manpower , and other necessary accessories for performing the job satisfactorily .
- 5.6 No deviation in respect to Technical specification and terms and conditions incorporated in the tender specification will be allowed. In this regard clear understanding / declaration shall be submitted alongwith tender document by the tenderer.
- 5.7 Net worth of the bidder should be Rupees **10 crores** for the last two consecutive years.
- 5.8 Annual turnover should be Rupees **40 crores** on an average of last three financial years
- 5.9 Those tenders which contain the full information and which comply with the requirements regarding technical and financial qualifications will be considered. Notwithstanding anything stated above, The WBPDC reserves the right to assess the tenderers capacity to perform the contract should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of The WBPDC In this regard the decision of the Corporation is final.
- 5.10 The tenderer shall furnish the following information :-
 - a. Capacity details of coal washery in terms of raw coal and washed coal
 - b. Spare capacity available to meet the requirement for WBPDC
 - C. Relevant certificates in proof of the existence of the washery.
- 5.11 The tenderer should have at least one year satisfactory performance record of running washery owned by the tenderer. Relevant documents in support to be submitted.

6. Period of Contract

The period of contract shall be **5 (five) years** from the actual date of commencement of work. The successful tenderer must commence the work within one month from the date of issuance of work order .The contract period may be extended upto 1 (one) year without any price escalation at the discretion of WBPDCCL authority provided the performance of the previous years is satisfactory.

- 5.3 The bidders must have document related to the wash ability characteristic of “F” grade ROM coal that would be normally supplied to the Washery as per the monthly allotted quantity
- 5.4 The Tenderer must be capable of supplying washed coal from their washery within ten days after release of Delivery order by MCL.
- 5.5 The Tenderer must have adequate experience , tools, machinery , manpower , and other necessary accessories for performing the job satisfactorily .
- 5.6 No deviation in respect to Technical specification and terms and conditions incorporated in the tender specification will be allowed. In this regard clear under standing / declaration shall be submitted alongwith tender document by the tenderer.
