Road Transportation of Coal from Simlong Colliery of ECL Rajmahal Area to BkTPP

NOTICE INVITING TENDER (N.I.T.)

Sealed Tenders are invited in two part bidding system, Part – I (Techno Commercial bid) and Part – II (Price bid) for road transportation of coal from Simlong Colliery, ECL, Rajmahal Area to Bakreswar Thermal Power Project (BkTPP), Dist: Birbhum, West Bengal by Dumpers/Tipppers, unloading at BkTPP from reliable and reputed/bonafide transport contractors having certain nos. of owned dumpers/tippers as stipulated below. The approximate distance of ECL Simlong colliery to BkTPP is 185 km. The party has to ensure that only good quality sized coal is loaded and transported.

1. QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR TENDERER :-

- i) The bidder should have experience in transportation of minimum 30,000 Metric Tonnes of coal by dumper/tipper per month within three years in a single contract to any public/private sector utility, covering a distance of at least 100 km.
- ii) The bidder should submit self certified copies of Work Order(s) along with satisfactory execution certificate/completion certificate or documents related to the fulfillment of the qualifying requirement.
- iii) The bidder should have a net worth of at least Rs 5 Crore. A latest Bank Solvency Certificate from any nationalized/scheduled bank regarding financial solvency should be furnished.
- iv) The bidder should have ownership of a fleet of at least 25 nos. Dumpers/Tipppers of 20 ton capacity or equivalent numbers of own dumpers/tippers to capable to transport 500 MT coal daily.
- v) The bidder should be able to submit a list of dumpers/tippers to be provided in the job along with the log books with ownership/hiring details.
- vi) The bidder should have sufficient work strength/employee strength in respective field of work and the party should submit the exhaustive employee list along with their PF account details/documents for the last financial year and valid labour license.
- vii) The bidder should submit a copy of PAN card as per the Income Tax Act and latest VAT/CST registration certificate.
- viii) Experience as sub contractor will be considered on the basis of performance certificate from end user.

- ix) The bidder should be capable of keeping the validity of offer for at least 180 days from the date of opening of price bid of the tender.
